Remembering a Friend....

I was shocked and saddened when I heard the news about the sudden demise of our friend, Navin Dedhia. Soon my mind started racing to our first meeting at Shree Mahavir Jain Vidyalaya, Gowalia Tank, Mumbai in June 1958. He and I were going to be roommates along with the other two (Hasmukh Shah & Shirish Patrawala). We also went to Elphinstone College for Science, riding the train from Grant Road Station to Churchgate and walking to the building through the Azad Maidan. We knew each other well for two years (1958-60). He was just like me coming from a family with limited means but high ethical and religious standards. We were so simple that we used to attend the college in our lengas rather than pants.

Navin was very punctual in performing pooja daily before breakfast. Navin was very smart in studies and won Sarla Devi Gold Medal by Shree Mahavir Jain Vidyala in 1960 scoring highest percentage in InterScience among SMJV Students in Mumbai. He had received Sri Rao Bahadur Pragmalaji Scholarship and Manibhai Jashbhai Prize for scoring high percentages marks in SSC among Kutchis . He successfully completed BE in Electrical Engineering at VJTI, Mumbai University in 1963. In 1966, he received MS Electrical engineering degree from Tennessee Technological University, Cookeville TN. He remained a lifetime employee of IBM with a successful career, starting at East Fishkill, New York and moving to IBM San Jose in 1976 until his retirement.

Navin & Jain Way of Life:

Navin has been a devout follower of Jainism in his daily life. He has been doing 9 or more fasts during Paryushan for many years. He was a very active member at Jain Center of Northern California (JCNC). He was awarded the 2017 JAINA Adult Leadership Award for his outstanding contributions promoting Jain Core Values in North America.

Navin was a pioneer, a great leader and a visionary for the KOJAIN from its formation to the present. He has served KOJAIN in many official capacities: First Secretary of the Board (1996-97), Vice President (2000-01) & (2002-03), Three-time President

(2006-07, 2010-11, 2012-13). I had a great pleasure working with him as a Region 4 Director from 2000 to 2011. His style was action oriented, consensus builder and inspiring.

Navin has attended all KOJAIN Sammelans, has written articles for the KOJAIN Souvenirs, served as an advisor on many committees and assisted in KOJAIN Directory. KOJAIN honored him with the Lifetime Achievement Award in 2018 @ the 9th KOJAIN Sammelan at San Mateo, CA.

Navin & Professionalism:

Navin has a spectacular professional career at IBM as a Quality Manager. Navin has served American Society for Quality (ASQ) in many high-profile positions as Board of Directors. Committee Chair in ASQ, National Centre for Quality Management in Mumbai and Industrial Advisory Board of the Electrical & computer Engineering Department at Tennessee Tech.

Navin is an author of two books and a credit for numerous articles in publications, presentations and serving on Boards of Quality Control Field. As a result he has been awarded many prestigious awards from ASQ, APQO and QIMPRO (Mumbai).

Navin will be missed immensely by us, his family and friends, by KOJAIN and JCNC and ASQ. We wish his soul eternal peace and bliss in his ongoing yatra to the Moksha.

KOJAIN is soliciting candidates for the 2022 Merit Scholarship. Eligibility Criteria and submission requirements for the Scholarship are listed below:

Eligibility Criteria:

- Graduating High School seniors planning to attend an accredited college or university full-time in the Fall of 2022.
- Applicant whose parents are KOJAIN Life Members.
- Grade point average of at least 3.0 on an unweighted 4.0 scale.

Your application must contain the following:

- Submit a 4-year high school transcript, including the 2021-2022 school year. Photocopies are acceptable. It can be sent by the school.
- Copies of American College Testing (ACT) or Scholastic Aptitude Testing (SAT), or any other entrance examination scores (optional).
- List and briefly describe any awards and/or extracurricular services and activities on separate pages (not to exceed two pages). Please provide enough information so that the selection committee will understand the nature of your services and activities.
- Photograph of your face (head and shoulders only) in jpg format.
- Essay Requirements & Topics are given below.

Write an essay in which you develop your point of view on any one of the topics presented below. Support your position with reasoning and examples taken from your readings, studies, experiences, or observations. The typed (double-spaced) essay must be at least 500 words but, must not exceed 800 words in Times New Roman Font, 12 point

- Discuss an extracurricular activity you participated in and how it impacted your life or your outlook on life.
- How has growing up with diverse cultures impacted your viewpoint of Jainism?
- Take a current event in United States and make connections to Indian culture broadly and to your culture specifically, and what changes would you propose?

Where to send your application: You can email all the documents in pdf format (picture in .jpg) to the following address: kojainscholarship@gmail.com. **Deadline for all materials will be April 30th, 2022**.

- Applicants will be notified of Judges' decision by the 2nd week of June 2022.
- Parents of applicants must be Life Members of KOJAIN. If you are not a life member you can still become a life member and apply for the Merit Scholarship. Membership Link .

Kutchi Community of Minnesota is very proud to present Shanti Shah who was presented a **LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT AWARD** by the India Association of Minnesota (IAM) at its annual "Connect India " event on March 19,2022 in recognition of her long time service to the Indian American Community. India Association of Minnesota (IAM) is a nonprofit organization that has served the Indian community for 49 years. She has been its active member for over 45 years. Shanti is a past President of IAM and a contributor to the founding of the School of India for Languages and Culture (SILC) and the Jain Center of Minnesota (JCM). She is the past President of Jain Center of Minnesota and currently serves on its Trustee Advisory Council (TAC) and as a JAINA Director. In 2021 she was responsible for leading a legislative bill signed last year by the Governor of Minnesota declaring August 15 as "India Day". This is a great accomplishment for the Indian Community in Minnesota.



Shanti Shah grew up in Malad, Mumbai, as Shanti Gangar. Shanti's family comes from Chasara, Kutch. Her mother's side established themselves in Malad nearly 100 years ago. She left Mumbai in 1967 for Canada and immigrated to the U.S. on fourth of July 1969, soon after astronaut Neil Armstrong and his team landed on the moon. After living in Upstate New York, she moved to Minnesota in 1972. Since then, she has been an active member of the Indian community which has grown from 3,000 to 50,000 people. The Institute for Global Health Department (IGH) at Michigan State University is sending Dr. Lawrence Prokop and Dr. Jacob Rowan, two professors of Osteopathic Rehab and Recovery, to Bidada Hospital to conduct an advanced certificate program for degreed Indian medical professionals to learn and study. The program at Jaya Rehab Center will begin the first week of November 2022 and will continue bi-annually at Jaya Rehab Center in Bidada Kutch Gujarat.

This project began when IGH went to Bidada hospital in January of 2020 and was BLOWN AWAY that a hospital of this caliber is located in a rural area. In addition to the Osteopathic program in November 2022, the IGH department is creating the first ever Study Abroad program in all of India specifically for medical students. 4th year MSU medical students will go to Bidada's annual medical camp in January to serve for 1 week.
