Up to three \$1000 scholarships will be offered. **KOJAIN is soliciting applications for the 2023 Merit Scholarship.** Eligibility Criteria and submission requirements for the Scholarship are listed below:

Please note:

- Last day of the submission of application is May 31, 2023. Applicant will be notified of Judges' decision by the 2nd week of June 2023.
- A list of winners will appear on the KOJAIN website at www.kojain.com and will be published in the September 2023 issue of KOJAIN newsletter.
- The KOJAIN Scholarship program is administered by the scholarship committee appointed by the KOJAIN Board of Directors and is made possible by KOJAIN members' tax-deductible contribution to the KOJAIN scholarship fund.

Eligibility Criteria:

- Graduating High School seniors planning to attend an accredited college or university full-time in the fall of 2023.
- Applicant whose parents are KOJAIN Life Members.
- Grade point average of at least 3.0 on an unweighted 4.0 scale.

Your application must contain the following:

- 1. Submit an unofficial 4-year high school transcript, including the 2022-2023 school year. Photocopies are acceptable.
- 2. Copies of American College Testing (ACT) or Scholastic Aptitude Testing (SAT), or any other entrance examination scores.
- 3. List and briefly describe any extracurricular services and activities. Please provide enough information so that the selection committee will understand the nature of your services and activities.
- 4. Photograph of your face (head and shoulders only) in jpg format.
- 5. Essay Requirements & Topics are given below.

Write a 500-word essay in which you develop your point of view on any one of the topics presented below. Support your position with reasoning and examples taken from your readings, studies, experiences, or observations.

Essay Topics:

- 1. Some students have a background, identity, interest, or talent that is so meaningful they believe their application would be incomplete without it. If this sounds like you, then please share your story.
- 2. Reflect on something that someone has done for you that has made you happy or thankful in a surprising way. How has this gratitude affected or motivated you?
- 3. Discuss an accomplishment, event, or realization that sparked a period of personal growth and a new understanding of yourself or others.

CommuTree - Community's Family Tree - by Narendra Shah, KOJAIN Region 5 Director

CommuTree is a unique platform that allows us all to create our own community's family tree and connect with our entire community. CommuTree is the trusted social platform where users create family trees and connect with their local Communities.

Communities, that puts extended Family Tree connections in the center of various Interactions like Matrimony, Businesses, Games, Jobs, Classifieds, Donations. It is the #1 App of the Gujarati and Kutchi Community having one million plus downloads already and increasing daily rapidly. We all can see our community's daily updates like: News, Matrimony, Death, New-Born, New Marriage, Engagement, Social, Religious, Job, Property, Commercial, Buy—Sell, Congratulations, Thank you, Condolences, Birthday, Marriage Anniversary, Death Anniversary, Academic, Medical, General, Daily Newsletter [Patrika], Jain calendar and almanac [Panchang], Oath of fasting [Pachakhan], etc.

For Americans, Europeans, Russians, Latinos, Africans, Chinese, and most others worldwide, they have Ancestry, FamilySearch, MyHeritage, FindMyPast, and such websites and web searches available. For our KOJAIN community, our ancestry details will unfortunately not show up in such websites and web searches.

So, Kudos to two youngsters of our own community, Atul Jivraj Nisar [Thoriari, Vagad, Kutch – Dahisar, Mumbai] and Amit Lalji Chheda [Samakhiari, Vagad, Kutch – Dahisar, Mumbai], started this great revolutionary venture CommuTree [meaning Community Tree – like Extended Family Tree for the entire Community showing internal relationship], at a very young age of around 25 years old, together in June 2008. I have posted my family tree up to more than 21 generations going back more than 400 years, in this CommuTree for my whole family and for all to see. It has worked like a miracle and a great blessing for our whole community. They also incorporated names and photographs of all and allowed online edit facility 24/7. It helps us with the understanding of relationships with anybody and everybody in our own community. It is available on smartphones, so we all can use it globally too. They started with one community and today they have covered all the Jain and Non-Jain; Kutchi, Gujarati, Marwadi, Rajasthani, and other communities and sub-communities [400 plus] and are ever expanding rapidly.

They allow only one community on one cell phone to allow exclusivity but at the same time it is a totally free service to all, and they survive only on the advertisements to serve the community at large. For basic Matrimony service they provide free service but for premium matrimony there is a nominal charge and for VIP Matrimony there is a higher charge, but it is spread throughout all the communities at once.

I kindly appeal to all of you to add your updated full details, with latest photographs, in CommuTree to help yourselves, your families, and our whole community at large, as soon as possible.

KOJAIN Matrimonial Initiative

With the goal to create a platform for North America based matrimonial candidates and their family to promote matrimonial alliances within the community, KOJAIN Matrimonial initiative was launched in 2022. We held 3 Parents Medavos (Gatherings), 2 Singles virtual mixers, and encouraged matrimonial advertisements in the KOJAIN newsletter in 2022.

Earlier this year (2023), we have launched the KOJAIN Matrimonial WhatsApp group for the candidates and their parents. This group has received enthusiastic response from the community so far. We have 38 male candidates and 13 female candidates actively registered in the group. Including the parents of the candidates, we have 120 active WhatsApp group members. These candidates are both from USA and Canada, with ages ranging from 25 to 44. The female candidate profiles are posted on Saturday and male candidate profiles are posted on Sunday. The group follows proper guidelines to handle the candidate information carefully. The candidates and parents have provided positive feedback so far.
